Background

The University of Illinois Statutes, Article II, Section 2. a. (1) state:

The University Senates Conference shall be made up of twenty members. The basic representation shall be two members from each senate. Additional members shall be apportioned to each senate, at least one from each senate, in numbers proportional to the number of faculty members on each campus. The apportionment shall be recalculated every five years. Each senate shall elect its own representatives from its membership.

PRASANTA KALITA (ACES)

Dr. Prasanta K. Kalita is a Professor in the Agricultural & Biological Engineering Department. He currently is a member of the UIUC Senate and serves as chair of the Committee on Committees. He is currently serving on the University Senate Conference. He served on the Senate Educational Policy Committee, chaired the Campus Committee on Race and Ethnicity (CORE), and the University IT Governance Security and Privacy Subcommittee. He served on Coursera Course Review Committee, Governing Documents Review Committee, and Noninstructional Space Task Force Committee on the campus level. Prasanta was a co-chair on Teaching Advancement Board (TAB), chaired the College of ACES Administrators Evaluation Committee, chaired the College of Engineering Grievance Committee, served on ACES P&T Committee and chaired the Campus Study Abroad Advisory Committee. Additionally, he has served on both colleges of Engineering and ACES Executive Committees. Prasanta has a well-funded research program both nationally and internationally, has guided more than 45 Ph.D. and MS graduate students, advised more than 70 undergraduate research students, and published extensively in peer reviewed journals. He has won departmental, college, campus, regional, and two national awards, and has been recognized with Distinguished Teacher Scholar Award on Campus. He is a Fellow of the American Society of Agricultural and Biological Engineers (ASABE). He has served as Associate Editor of the Transactions of the ASABE and Applied Engineering in Agriculture as well as the Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Spatial Hydrology.

WILLIAM MAHER (LIBR)

William Maher has been a Professor of Library Administration since 1977 and University Archivist since 1995. His deep commitment to shared governance is evidenced by over 16 years in the Senate. He has served as chair of the University Statutes and Senate Procedures Committee and a member of the Senate Executive Committee since 2006. He is serving on the current Search Committee for the Chancellor and previously served on the 2011 Chancellor search committee and for the Dean of LAS (2013-14). He has represented the UIUC Senate on the University Senates Conference 2013-15. Beyond the University, he has held leadership positions in regional, national, and international professional organizations. His research specialization is in archival management and intellectual property, and he has served as a NGO head of delegation in Geneva at the World Intellectual Property Organization.

GAY MILLER (VMED)

Gay Miller joined the Illinois faculty in 1994. She came from Ohio State to Illinois as Professor and Associate Dean for Academic and Student Affairs in the College of Veterinary Medicine. She is currently Professor and Division Chair of Epidemiology and Preventive Medicine in the College of Veterinary Medicine, and Adjunct Professor in both Veterinary Clinical Medicine, and Agricultural and Consumer Economics. Her relevant Illinois campus service work includes Provost's Campus Budget Oversight Committee, Chair 2003-2005; Provost's Promotion and Tenure Committee; University of Illinois Senator; Senate Committee on Student Discipline; Senate Budget Committee; Senate Committee on Committees; the Senate Committee on Educational Policy, Chair 2011-2015; Senate Executive Committee, 2011-2016 and Chair 2015-2016; University Senates Conference 2013-2016, and Chair of USC Academic Affairs and Research Committee, 2014-2016. She particularly enjoyed her service work as Chair of Educational Policy, a committee that touches all educational and research aspects of the campus.

Gay Miller's main research focus has been on foreign animal diseases (FADs) since an AAAS Science and Technology Policy at the USDA (2006-2007). Her primary interests now are in the epidemiology, economics, and social impacts of FAD outbreaks in food producing animals. She has taught mainly veterinary and graduate students on a variety of subjects including epidemiology, food safety, public health, disease outbreak investigation, biosecurity, and the economics of food animal disease prevention and control. She has written hundreds of scientific papers, reports and articles. Over the last five years, she has given dozens of invited talks about FAD preparedness and response at national and international forums. She developed and taught her first online class in fall 2015, which was an introduction to epidemiology with tropical disease examples, developed and delivered initially as a face-to-face course that she gave in Sierra Leone at Njala University in spring, 2014.

FACULTY BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCHES

LARRY DEBROCK (BUS)

Lawrence DeBrock, Professor of Finance and Dean Emeritus, College of Business, earned his Ph.D. in Economics from Cornell in 1980. He served as the ninth Dean of the College of Business from 2009-2015. Prior to that, he served as Acting Associate Dean of Faculty as well as Associate Dean for Graduate and Professional Programs. Professor DeBrock has long been associated with the Illinois MBA and has won many awards in graduate and professional teaching, including the Campus Award for Excellence in Graduate and Professional Teaching in 2001, the MBA Faculty of the Year Award in 2000. He received the Campus Award for Distinguished Undergraduate Teaching (the Luckman Award) in 1992. His research interests lie in the area of applied microeconomics and focus on topics in industrial organization, regulatory issues, health economics, and labor economics. He is currently finishing his 37th year on the faculty at Illinois.

GEORGE FRANCIS (LAS)

My interests are unconventional: publishing in pure and applied mathematics, but also collaborating with engineers, psychologists, and artists. I was Donna Cox's 1987 co-PI for the NCSA-Beckman Renaissance Experimental Laboratory. In 2013 I collaborated with NY artist Tony Robbin and 9 Illinois Geometry Lab undergraduates. Their graduate mentor, Eliana Duarte, presented our results at an architectural conference in Spain. I've taught in the Campus Honors Program since 1990, serving on its faculty advisory board. I was first elected to the Senate as an assistant professor, and served on diverse committees: Student Life, Campus Operations, IT (chair). On the USC, I sat across from 5 presidents in 6 years. On the Committee on Committees, I will support shared governance between administration, faculty, and students. My platform is: Personal qualifications outweigh prominence and factional allegiances. I will balance Senate committees between eager young faculty and seasoned, committed mentors from the entire campus.

ISABEL MOLINA (LAS)

Isabel Molina-Guzmán is an associate professor the Department of Media & Cinema Studies in College of Media and the Department of Latina/Latino Studies in College of Liberal Arts Sciences. She is a leading researcher on ethnicity, race, gender and the media in traditional and digital forms. Since her arrival at UIUC in 2002, she has served both colleges and the campus in a variety of positions: Chair of the Department of Latino Studies (2007-2008; 2009-2012); Member of the College of LAS STAR team (2009-2011); College of Media Executive Committee (2012-2013). Prof. Molina was also a member of Provost's Stewarding Excellence Committee review of small academic units on campus (2009-2010); Provost/Chancellor Advisory Committee (2012-2013); Provost Advisory Committee (2007-2008). In 2008 she became a CIC Academic Leadership Fellow. Finally, Prof. Molina participated in the College of LAS Dean's Search (2008) and Provost Search Committee in (2008-2009).

LISA MONDA-AMAYA (EDUC)

Lisa Monda-Amaya is a Professor in the Department of Special Education. She served as Director of Research Collaboration for the Center for Education in Small Urban Communities for 6 years. As a faculty member at the University of Illinois for the last 27 I have served on a number of campus and college committees including the Committee on Committees. For years she has coordinated teacher preparation programs, and has received nearly \$5 million in grant funding. At the state level Dr. Monda-Amaya has been heavily involved in personnel preparation and certification activities and has influenced policy decisions in the State of Illinois. She has served on the Executive Boards for national organizations and has received numerous teaching awards including the Award for Excellence in University Teaching for the State of Illinois (ITED), the Campus Award for Undergraduate Teaching, and the College of Education's Outstanding Undergraduate Professor and Career Teaching Awards.

ROB MOTL (AHS)

Robert W. Motl is currently a Professor in the Department of Kinesiology and Community Health and affiliate of the Neuroscience Program. Prof. Motl received an undergraduate degree from the San Diego State University, Master's from University of Wyoming, and doctorate from the University of Georgia. Prof. Motl has research interests in the area of physical activity behavior and its measurement, predictors, and consequences in persons with neurological conditions. Prof. Motl is a Fellow in the Society for Behavioral Medicine, and member of the Consortium of Multiple Sclerosis Centers. Prof. Motl current serves as a member of the Social and Behavioral Sciences Working Group and chairs the Biomedical and Health Sciences Institutional Review Board. Prof. Motl further chaired study section for the National Multiple Sclerosis Society over the past 5 years.

SIOBHAN SOMERVILLE (LAS)

Siobhan B. Somerville (Ph.D., English, Yale University) is an Associate Professor in the Departments of English and Gender and Women's Studies, as well as an affiliated faculty member in the Unit for Criticism and Interpretive Theory and the Department of African American Studies. She is author of Queering the Color Line: Race and the Invention of Homosexuality in American Culture (Duke UP). Her research and teaching interests include: interdisciplinary studies of race and sexuality; American literature; queer theory; African American literature; law and humanities; film; and feminist theory. Formerly an Associate Dean of the Graduate College and Interim Director of the Gender and Women's Studies Department, Somerville has served on several campus-wide committees, including the Chancellor and Provost Committee on LGBT Concerns; the Chancellor's Committee on Diversity; the Interdisciplinary Working Group in the Humanities; and the Equal Opportunity and Inclusion Committee of the Academic Senate.
