EP.19.42 Report of Administrative Approvals at the February 5, 2019 meeting of the EPC.

**Undergraduate Programs**

**Minor in Criminology, Law, and Society** – Add SOC 479, Law and Society (3 hours), to the list of list of core courses from which students are to select 3 hours. Add SOC 375, Criminal Justice System (3 hours) and SOC 479, Law and Society (3 hours) to the list of courses from which students are to select 9 hours, with at least 3 at the 300- or 400-level. Students may select SOC 479 from the second list if not taken as part of the core. The additions of these courses expand the range of choices for students and do not change the number of hours required for the minor.

This is to correct EP.19.31, which incorrectly identified the minor impacted as the minor in Sociology. This above-named minor is offered by the Department of Sociology but is correctly named in this item.
