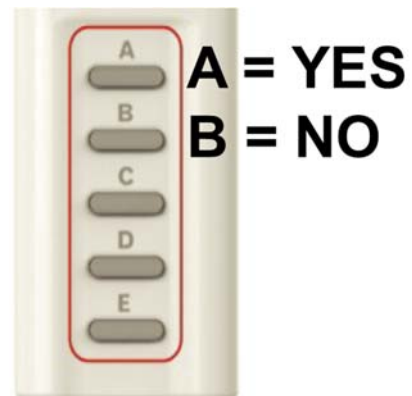
* The "precedence" column comes into play when there are multiple motions on the floor. For example, there could be a main motion, and a motion to amend, and a motion to refer to committee. The lowest "precedence" number is the motion that gets voted on first; in this example, the numbers are 13 for the main motion, 11 for the amendment, and 10 for referral to committee. So referral gets voted on first; if it loses, then amendment; then the main motion, which is always last. A new main motion (precedence 13) may be made only if there is no other motion on the floor.

Using the i>clicker 2

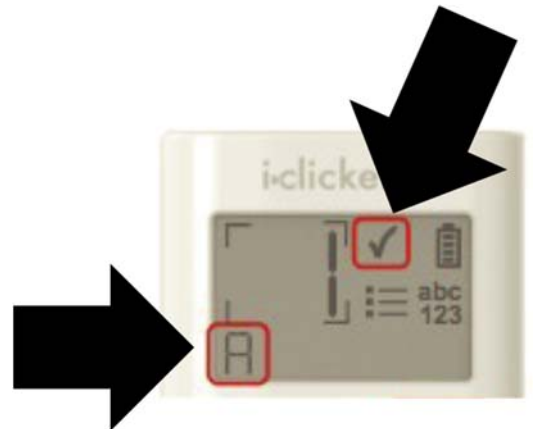
1. “1” denotes the first candidate on the ballot.

The University of Illinois *Statutes*, Article II, Section 2. a. (1) state:

The apportionment shall be recalculated every five years. Each senate shall elect its own representatives from its membership.

Lawrence DeBrock (BUS)

Lawrence DeBrock, Professor of Finance and Dean Emeritus, College of Business, earned his Ph.D. in Economics from Cornell in 1980. He served as the ninth Dean of the College of Business from 2009-2015. Prior to that, he served as Interim Dean, Acting Associate Dean of Faculty as well as Associate Dean for Graduate and Professional Programs in the College of Business. Professor DeBrock has long been associated with the Illinois MBA and has won many awards in teaching, including the Campus Award for Excellence in Graduate and Professional Teaching in 2001 and the Campus Award for Distinguished Undergraduate Teaching (the Luckman Award) in 1992. 2017-18 will be his 39th year on the faculty at the University of Illinois.
