MINUTES

**I. ANNUAL MEETING OF THE FACULTY**

Senate Executive Committee (SEC) Jeffrey Eric Jenkins (FAA) called the Annual Meeting of the Faculty to order at 3:10 pm.

**WELCOME**

SEC Chair Jenkins welcomed everyone and began by inviting Chancellor Jones to read the land acknowledgement statement.

**CHANCELLOR'S REMARKS**

Chancellor Robert Jones thanked the Senate for the invitation to this meeting and to have a broader conversation with the faculty. Chancellor Jones also thanked all faculty members who have chosen to serve on the Senate and Senate committees, and the important work that has been done through shared governance. The events of the last couple of years is a reminder of how important it is as a part of shared governance to have collaboration, trust, and respect as we work together to solve complex issues.

Chancellor Jones shared that COVID-19 positivity rates are down, and the larger community is back to the medium range down. Free COVID testing continues to be available at the Illini Union and testing is also available to the community through SHIELD IL at CRCE (Campus Recreation Center East). Chancellor Jones also encouraged everyone to continue getting the COVID boosters as they become available.

The University released its 10-day numbers about a month ago. The total enrollment is now 56,644, which is a record high. The 7,957 new first year student class is smaller than last year, but the lower enrollment was strategic. The University of Illinois continues to be the largest provider of undergraduate education in the State of Illinois.

The faculty hiring initiative has not kept pace with the increase in enrollment. The new faculty hiring initiative is aggressive and bold about the need to accelerate the hire and to retain the best and the brightest faculty. This initiative will invest at least \$50 million to help address the faculty-student ratio.

The search for a new Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and Provost is underway with the Gies College of Business Dean Jeff Brown as the chair. The position of Provost is critically important to the mission of the University and a robust pool of candidates is anticipated.

Chancellor Jones discussed the importance of the state-wide tour President Killeen arranged with the three Chancellors and other key staff. The goal was to visit stakeholders, build relationships, and highlight the work that is being done individually and collectively that drives the State's economy and economic educational growth. Some stops on the tour included East St. Louis, Dixon Springs, and Cairo. This annual tour is a reminder of the excellence that the University of Illinois System brings to the State of Illinois and brings University leadership up close and personal with the impact the University is having on the State.

Chancellor Jones accompanied President Killeen and Interim Chancellor Reyes from University of Illinois Chicago to Mexico City. There are more than 1,400 alums in Mexico City. The University of Illinois now has an office at UNAM (National Autonomous University of Mexico).

Chancellor Jones also mentioned Ralph Nuzzo, G.L. Clark Professor Emeritus of Analytical Chemistry at Illinois and Professor Emeritus of Chemistry, is one of the recipients of the 2022 Kavli Prize in Nanoscience.

Chancellor Jones invited everyone to the State of the University Address on October 27, 2022. Immediately following is the Strategic Planning Summit – Boldly Illinois 2030 Strategic Plan.

#### **PRESIDENT'S REMARKS**

University of Illinois System President Timothy Killeen gave the following remarks. President Killeen noted the four strategic pillars – #1 And Institution of and for Our Students, #2 Research and Scholarship with Global Impact, #3 A Healthy Future for Illinois and the Midwest, and #4 Tomorrow's University Today.

This platform for performance that has been built is driven and based on shared governance. Shared governance is alive and well at the University of Illinois System. The System has worked well together to address many topics including the pandemic, safe campuses, mental health issues, improve abilities to avoid sexual misconduct, updated the *Statutes*, and many other important topics. The University has good alignment with State decision making and is especially important to the future. The University just received a 5% increase in its operating budget from the State. This increase is welcome after a couple of decades of an erosion of State support. This also included \$20 million for MAP grants (Monetary Award Program) which helps to support our commitment to underrepresented and underserved communities. The increase also supported a 3.5% base salary program. President Killeen shared that Chancellor Jones has a plan to recruit 200 faculty over the next several years. This is a significant growth and not just replacements for those retiring.

The University's commitment to providing affordable and world-class education has led to growth in the student body. Collectively the University System is at an all-time high of 94,861 students. A world-class education at scale for an affordable price in an environment that is full of brilliant scholarship.

There has been growth not only in enrollment but also growth in research volume which is now at \$1.2 billion. There are notable new partnerships with IBM (International Business Machines), NIH (National Institutes of Health), NSF (National Science Foundation), and across the board. The DPI (Discovery Partners Institute) and IIN (Illinois Innovation Network) currently has 22 science teams. The University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign has benefited from IIN by making the renovations happen in Illini Hall, Altgeld Hall, and NCSA. The work that came out of the COVID pandemic has led to the possibility of a new endowed professorship and equipment purchases that would not have been possible.

The University of Illinois System really has really been able to quantify the impact on the State of Illinois. President Killeen shared the following numbers; \$19 billion in total annual economic impact; the University System accounts for 2.1% gross state product; 1 in every 46 jobs in the State comes out of the University System either directly or indirectly; for every dollar students invest in their education, they receive \$5.2 back in future hire earnings; 75% of UI graduates live and work in the State of Illinois; System research spending generated \$1.3 billion in added income; UI healthcare system created another \$1.6 billion; for every \$1 from the State, the tax base gets \$3.1 in return, and philanthropic efforts have exceeded the goal of \$3.1 billion.

The State of Illinois has some challenges it needs to grapple with. For example, Cairo, a town on the confluence of the Mississippi and Ohio rivers, does not have a grocery store or gas station, young people are leaving, and the older population is struggling with diabetes and obesity. Building jobs and opportunities for those folks in rural Illinois is important. Even six miles south of UIC you can see a drop in life expectancy. UIC is opening a healthcare hub to deal with chronic illnesses. The single most important asset the State of Illinois has is the University of Illinois.

#### **OPEN DISCUSSION**

Faculty senator Baker (ACES) noted that University of Illinois Extension is present in all 102 counties of the State of Illinois.

**VI. SENATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE CHAIR’S REMARKS**

Chair Jenkins shared that he met with the Provost’s Council of Deans, at the request of Interim Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and Provost William Bernhard, to discuss SEC’s role in shared governance in collaboration with administration. Jenkins noted the ongoing proposed revisions to the *Statutes* that the Senate Committee on University Statutes and Senate Procedures continues to work on. And the work both the Senate Committee on Academic Freedom and Tenure (AFT) and the Senate Committee on General University Policy (GP) have done to formulate an approach to department political statements. Jenkins reported on the Senate’s engagement with the Office of the Vice Chancellor for Research and Innovation on faculty’s shared insights regarding research policies. Jenkins also requested that the Deans help in recruiting the best and brightest members of their units to be engaged with shared governance through service in the Senate and on Senate committees.

On behalf of CC, Chair Sandler introduced and moved approval of the slate of nominees listed on CC.23.12.

10/10/22-09 Student senator Patwardhan (ENGR) made a self-nomination for the student vacancy on University Statutes and Senate Procedures. The nomination was accepted, and floor nominations were declared closed.

10/10/22-10 Through the online voting system Poll Everywhere, the slate of nominees on CC.23.12 was approved with 106 in favor, 0 opposed, and 5 abstentions.

10/10/22-11 HD.23.05\* Nomination for Honorary Degree Awards – Liay, Rosakis

On behalf of the Senate Committee on Honorary Degrees, committee member Krista Keller introduced and moved approval of honorary degrees for Louis Liay, Former Executive Director of the University of Illinois Alumni Association; and Ares Rosakis, Theodore Von Karman Professor of Aeronautics and Mechanical Engineering, Division of Engineering and Applied Science at the California Institute of Technology.

10/10/22-12 Through the online voting system Poll Everywhere, Liay and Rosakis were approved for honorary degrees with 93 in favor, 2 opposed, and 22 abstentions.

10/10/22-13 SP.20.07\* Revision to the *Bylaws*, Part B.11 (Senate Committees), Part E (Governing and Advisory Bodies), and Part F (Senate Representatives to Other Bodies)

On behalf of the Senate Committee on University Statutes and Senate Procedures, Chair Gilmore introduced and moved approval of SP.20.07. Gilmore noted that these clarifications were suggested by the Eighth Senate Review Commission.

10/10/22-14 Through the online voting system Poll Everywhere, SP.20.07 was approved with 104 in favor, 0 opposed, and 11 abstentions.

10/10/22-15 SP.22.03\* Proposed Revisions to the *Constitution*, Article VI, Section 9 (Senate review) and the *Bylaws*, Part D.1.a – Senate Executive Committee Duties

On behalf of the SP, Chair Gilmore introduced SP.22.03 for a first reading. Gilmore noted that the proposed language would be more directive on the periodic review process. Faculty senator Lumetta (ENGR) expressed concern that the new language regarding the periodic review committee might not allow for the committee to be constituted if there are not members from each electorate. Gilmore stated that was not the intention and would relay the concern to SP.
