MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign Senate was called to order at 3:24 pm by Professor Emeritus H. George Friedman, Jr. serving as the Presiding Officer of the Senate with Kaamilyah Abdullah-Span, JD serving as Parliamentarian.

II. PUBLIC COMMENT

No requests received.

III. SENATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE CHAIR'S REMARKS

SEC Chair Jenkins (FAA) shared the following remarks.

SEC requested feedback regarding OT-387, University of Illinois System Values and Principles document from the Senate Committee on Academic Freedom and Tenure (AF) and the Senate Committee on General University Policy (GP). Both AF and GP submitted reports to SEC which contained specific and general concerns about language in the Values and Principles document and both reports were forwarded to the University Senates Conference (USC). Jenkins will keep the Senate updated on this item.

In the coming weeks, on campus interviews will be held for the Associate Chancellor and Vice Provost for Finance, Budget, and Capital Resources. SEC has been invited to participate in that process.

Jenkins called attention to the report from the Senate Committee on Educational Policy (EP), EP.24.068, Interim Guidance Regarding Implementation of the Illinois Board of Higher Education 40 Upper-Division Hour Criterion.

The SEC Research Policy working group has been collaborating with the Office of the Vice Chancellor for Research and Innovation (OVCRI) on the creation of a functioning Senate Committee on Research Policy. Once the duties and membership have been outlined, the Senate Committee University Statutes and Senate Procedures (SP) will present a proposal to the Senate for its approval.

SP continues to work on a response to the proposed revisions to the University *Statutes* through a document referred to as ST-83. SP has consulted with a wide variety of constituencies across the University.

Jenkins advised senators to continue to take care of themselves and those around them as COVID-19 continues to claim lives. Many individuals continue to suffer from the international discord we are witnessing on several fronts. Jenkins encouraged taking

advantage of the numerous resources available to faculty, staff, and students if found struggling.

IV. CHANCELLOR'S REMARKS

Chancellor Robert Jones shared the following remarks after noting the recent inclement weather.

Chancellor Jones drew attention to the commencement ceremonies that were held in December. This important event often gets overlooked. Almost 4,000 new graduates participated in various ceremonies across the University. Some graduates will return for the larger ceremony in May, but for many this is their last opportunity to celebrate with this University.

The fall 2024 application deadline was January 5, 2024 and garnered an all-time high of 73,597 applications. This shows the demand for an Illinois education. Admissions letters have been sent to those who met the early action deadline, and the remainder of admissions letters will be sent in March.

After many years of advocating for an updated FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) process, changes have finally been made. However, there have been numerous glitches with the 2024-2025 online FAFSA process. This year, there will be less time to process and make decisions about financial aid, compile offers, and then distribute the information to students.

The Legislative Kickoff Reception invited legislators to campus to provide an overview of different areas of the University. This year, legislators were invited to the Research Park to understand the research mission, the outreach and engagement, the technology mission of this University and the role it plays as a role for this community, state, and nation. This is a great way to reach out to state legislators and it achieved a positive response from legislators.

V. QUESTIONS

Faculty senator Rana (LAS) expressed concern about the negative feedback the Department of Asian American Studies received in response to a departmental statement posted to their website and subsequent removal of the statement. Rana also expressed concern about freedom of speech, and shared his opinion that the guidelines established by the University Senate were not being enforced equitably across all units. Chancellor Jones replied that he and University administrators have been clear about the commitment to open dialogue and conversations about some of the most challenging issues in our society. The Guidelines on Departmental Statements list expectations for departmental statements and must be adhered to. This does not mean free speech and academic freedom has been abandoned at this University. Chancellor

Jones and Provost Coleman are committed to the ability for faculty and staff at this University to articulate their academic freedom and exercise free speech.

Faculty senator Deeke (LAS) expressed concern for the safety of students, faculty, and staff during the recent inclement weather that produced icy walkways, and asked what protocols were followed when deciding to continue with in-person instruction. Chancellor Jones noted that the January 2 ice storm did create several difficulties. Several discussions occurred the night before the storm regarding the weather forecast of inclement weather. The forecasted storm moved in a different path than expected. After further discussion the afternoon of the storm, it was clear the weather was deteriorating faster than anticipated. Instruction moved to remote learning and then resumed later the next day. Decisions are based on discussions with the Emergency Management team and the information available through the National Weather Service and local weather services.

Faculty senator and Chair of the Senate Committee on General University Policy (GP), Burbules (EDUC) noted that GP developed the Guidelines on Departmental Statements last year and were intended to be applied consistently across the campus.
