MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign Senate was called to order at 3:10 pm by Professor Emeritus H. George Friedman, Jr. serving as the Presiding Officer of the Senate with Kaamilyah Abdullah-Span, JD serving as Parliamentarian.

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

02/06/23-01

Without objection, the minutes of the December 5, 2022 meeting were approved as distributed by unanimous consent.

III. APPROVAL OF FLOOR PRIVILEGES

No requests received.

IV. PUBLIC COMMENT

No requests received.

V. SENATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE CHAIR'S REMARKS

Senate Executive Committee (SEC) Chair Jeffrey Eric Jenkins (FAA) welcomed everyone. Jenkins noted the passing of faculty senator Bruce Rosenstock (LAS) and mentioned the resolution on today's agenda in honor of his passing. Jenkins shared that the Governor's disaster proclamation that allows for online meetings will expire on May 11 and the Senate will continue to meet online until that time. There are discussions being held about further modifying the Illinois Open Meetings Act (OMA) regarding online meetings. Jenkins encouraged submission of honorary degree award nominations for commencement 2024. Senate elections will be held soon along with a call for interest in serving on Senate committees.

VI. CHANCELLOR'S REMARKS

Chancellor Robert Jones shared the following remarks. Illinois is now operating under the revised COVID-19 testing and vaccination guidelines that were announced by the University System President Timothy Killeen. There has been no significant increase in COVID-19 cases in the University community with the start of the spring semester and the Champaign-Urbana community cases have also remained low. Free COVID-19 PCR tests will continue to be available to faculty, staff, and students at Campus Recreation Center East (CRCE).

Chancellor Jones shared concerns about artificial intelligence (AI) advancements that may have negative impacts on higher education. ChatGPT is an AI-powered chatbot developed by OpenAI, based on the GPT (Generative Pretrained Transformer) language model. Members of University leadership are engaged in conversations about the

implications of the use of ChatGTP. The Office of the Provost is developing standard language that can be used on course syllabi stating that students cannot use ChatGPT, or under what conditions the ChatGPT tool can be used in the course. Faculty members will have the freedom to choose how ChatGPT is used or not used in their course.

Chancellor Jones thanked everyone that has been involved in the ongoing search for the next Provost. Finalists have been making public presentations to the campus community. Jones also thanked the SEC and other Senate representatives that have provided valuable feedback about the candidates so far.

Chancellor Jones offered his congratulations to the seven faculty members that have been elected Fellows of the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS). Jones also commended another faculty member that was recently awarded a 2022 National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) Fellowship.

There were a record number of admissions applications and many of those applicants recently received their invitation for admission to the University. Another round of invitations will be sent in the coming weeks.

Chancellor Jones thanked Jenkins for sharing his acknowledgement of the sad news of Professor Bruce Rosenstock's passing. Rosenstock was known not only for his work in shared governance through the Senate, but also for his scholarly work.

IX. PROPOSALS

02/06/23-09 CC.23.16* Election of Members on Standing Committees of the Senate at the February 6, 2023 Senate Meeting on

On behalf of the Senate Committee on Committees (CC), Chair Sandler introduced and moved approval of item CC.23.16. There were no nominations from the floor and floor nominations were declared closed.

02/06/23-10 Through the online voting system Poll Everywhere, the slate of nominees on item CC.23.16 were approved with 104 in favor, 0 opposed, and 6 abstentions.

02/06/23-11 GP.23.05* Resolution in Honor of Professor Bruce Rosenstock

On behalf of the Senate Committee on General University Policy (GP), Chair Burbules introduced and moved approval of item GP.23.05. Presiding Officer Friedman announced a moment of silence in observance of Rosenstock's passing.

02/06/23-12 Through the online voting system Poll Everywhere, item GP.23.05 was approved with 103 in favor, 0 opposed, and 5 abstentions.

02/06/23-13 EQ.21.01* Proposed Updated Diversity Statement

On behalf of the Senate Committee on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (EQ), Chair Pionke summarized the development of EQ.21.01 and moved approval of the item.

02/06/23-14 Through the online voting system Poll Everywhere, item EQ.21.01 was approved with 82 in favor, 6 opposed, and 32 abstentions. EQ.21.01 will be forwarded to the Office of the Vice Chancellor for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion.

02/06/23-15 SP.20.25* Revision to the Senate *Constitution* and *Bylaws* Providing for Routine and Emergency Electronic Participation in Meetings of the Senate and its Committees

On behalf of the Senate Committee on University Statutes and Senate Procedures (SP), Chair Gilmore introduced SP.20.25 for a second reading and then moved approval of the item. Gilmore noted this item specifies how electronic participation works and establishes sections in the *Bylaws* around electronic participation in emergency and non-emergency situations.

Faculty senator Selznick (LAS) expressed concern about the Illinois Open Meetings Act (OMA) language that states a protected minority identity must be permitted to join a meeting electronically by a more privileged abled body majority.

02/06/23-16 Through the online voting system Poll Everywhere, item SP.20.25 was approved with 104 in favor, 1 opposed, and 9 abstentions. The required two-thirds majority was reached.

02/06/23-17 SP.21.05* Revision to the *Bylaws*, Part D.7 – Conference on Conduct Governance

On behalf of SP, Chair Gilmore introduced and moved approval of SP.21.05. Gilmore noted that this body coordinates its work with the Office of the Dean of Students. This item would also rename the body as the Senate Council on Student Conduct Expectations and Accountability.

02/06/23-18 Through the online voting system Poll Everywhere, item SP.21.05 was approved with 81 in favor, 1 opposed, and 29 abstentions. The required two-thirds majority was reached.

02/06/23-19 SP.23.07* Revision to the *Bylaws*, Part D.7 – Conference on Conduct Governance

On behalf of SP, Chair Gilmore introduced SP.23.07 for a first reading. Gilmore noted the proposed revision would update the name of the Senate from “Senate of the Urbana Champaign Campus” to “University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign Senate”, which is consistent with the change in the *Statutes* from campus to university. As a first reading, no vote was taken.

X. COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE DISCUSSION

02/06/23-20 A motion was made and seconded to move into a Committee of the Whole Discussion on item SP.23.05. Without objection, the Senate moved into a Committee of the Whole Discussion via unanimous consent.

02/06/23-21 SP.23.05* Committee of the Whole Discussion Regarding the Proposed Elimination of the Category of “Academic Staff” and Proposed Changes to Academic Freedom in the *Statutes* (as initiated by USC ST-83)

SP Chair Gilmore gave a brief introduction stating that the term “academic staff” is used in different ways in different portions of the *Statutes*. Gilmore noted the following instances of the term “academic staff” in the *Statutes* (1) Article III, Section 3.d [The Dean], (2) Article VIII, Section 1.b [Changes in Academic Organization, Definitions], (3) Article IX, Section 3 [Appointments, Ranks, and Promotions of the Academic and Administrative Staff], and (4), Article IX, Section 4.a [Principles Governing Employment of Academic and Administrative Staffs].

Presiding Officer Friedman shared that SEC voted to increase the speaking time per speaker from three minutes to six minutes which will be strictly enforced.

The following summarized comments were shared.

- The term “academic staff” as it is currently used in the *Statutes* is vague and confusing. teaching assistants and research assistants currently fall under “academic staff”, yet they should not have academic freedom.
- There are AP employees that are researchers at the Prairie Research Institute that do have academic freedom, and this should be considered when making revisions.
- Academic freedom applies to all academic staff. The current “academic staff” is a large pool of individuals. The proposed revision changes the pool of individuals that would have academic freedom.
- Academic freedom should be connected to an activity and not to a position.
- Looking at activities of research and teaching, and the levels of supervision should be used to determine which persons should have academic freedom.
- The conceptual discussion about who should have academic freedom and who should not needs to occur before revising the language in the *Statutes*.
- Requested that SP thoroughly explore the suggestion that academic freedom should be connected to an activity and not to a position.
- Another aspect to consider surrounding academic freedom is the funding source for the salary that is being paid. Many postdoctoral researchers are hired for a specific project or grant. Removing the umbrella term “academic staff” may cause other issues.

Chair Gilmore thanked everyone for their comments and invited additional comments to be send via email.

02/06/23-22 A motion was made and seconded to rise and report (end discussion). Without objection, the motion to rise and report was approved via unanimous consent.
