MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign Senate was called to order at 3:10 pm by Professor Emeritus H. George Friedman, Jr. serving as the Presiding Officer of the Senate with Kaamilyah Abdullah-Span, JD serving as Parliamentarian.

II. REMOTE PARTICIPATION

03/04/24-01

Without objection, remote participation was approved by unanimous consent.

III. PUBLIC COMMENT

Caitlin Vtosky Clarke, Teaching Assistant Professor in the Department of Kinesiology & Community in the College of Applied Health Sciences (AHS) voiced her support for renovations to the current Illinois Ice Arena Facility.

IV. SENATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE CHAIR'S REMARKS

Faculty senator (FAA) and SEC Chair, Jeffrey Eric Jenkins shared the following remarks.

The Senate Committee on University Statutes and Senate Procedures (SP) has diligently been working on the comprehensive revisions to the *Statutes* referred to as ST-83. SP is synthesizing feedback from several committee of the whole discussions along with comments from the Senate Committee on Academic Freedom and Tenure (AF). Recommendations from SP regarding ST-83 are forthcoming at the April 1, 2024 Senate meeting. The Urbana Senate is the last of the three university senates to provide feedback to the University Senates Conference (USC). SP also plans to submit *Bylaws* language to establish a standing Senate Committee on Research Policy before the end of the academic year.

Chair Jenkins encouraged everyone to take care of themselves and their students. Spring break will hopefully be a time for many to refresh before returning to finish the remainder of the spring semester. There are many resources available for faculty, staff, and students who find themselves struggling.

V. CHANCELLOR'S REMARKS

Chancellor Robert Jones encouraged everyone to use spring break to find some downtime and recharge to finish the semester and shared the following remarks.

Chancellor Jones reported Governor Pritzker is an advocate for investing in higher education. Pritzker announced a \$10 million investment in the MAP (Monetary Award Program) grant program. MAP funding is one of the ways to keep the cost of higher education affordable and accessible for students. The University of Illinois Urbana-

Champaign will receive a 1.8% increase from the State of Illinois. Governor Pritzker was on campus today at the Integrated Bioprocessing Research Laboratory (IBRL) to show his support for the Illinois Fermentation and Agriculture Biomanufacturing Hub (iFAB). iFAB is part of Innovate Illinois, a public-private partnership designed to make a coordinated effort to secure federal funding that is available through federal programs like the CHIPS (Creating Helpful Incentives to Produce Semiconductors) and Science Act.

The US Department of State recognized Illinois as one of the top producers of Fulbright student grant recipients and has been on the list for the last six of the last seven years. These are very highly competitive grants.

Chancellor Jones thanked senators for their support in recommending Jeanne Gang for an honorary degree award which will be conferred at the 2024 commencement ceremony in May. Gang will also serve as the 2024 commencement speaker that same day. Gang is one of the few people that can say she has influenced the skyline of some of world's most important cities.

Dalpiaz noted the proposed revision would specify the Senate’s delegation of eponymic renaming duties to the Joint Advisory Committee and require that committee to report to the Senate as appropriate. The proposal also makes some updates for language consistency. No discussion.
- 03/04/24-22 By i-clicker and show of hands, item SP.24.02 was approved with 117 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstentions. The required two-thirds majority was achieved.

- On behalf of the Senate Committee on Educational Policy (EP), Chair Miller introduced and moved approval of SP.24.071. Miller noted that the Division of General Studies (DGS) is currently an administrative unit; however, it was originally created as a unit within the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. DGS gathered feedback from various constituencies and the renaming was largely supported by those constituencies and students.
- EP Chair Miller noted that the new name, Division of Exploratory Studies, is widely adopted throughout higher education. A couple of student senators voiced their dislike for the new name. Sarah Watson, Director of the Division of General Studies, shared

additional information about how they chose the new name and the communication strategy on disseminating information about the new name.
