MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign Senate was called to order at 3:14 pm by Professor Emeritus H. George Friedman, Jr. serving as the Presiding Officer of the Senate with William Maher serving as Parliamentarian.

II. REMOTE PARTICIPATION

04/01/24-01 Remote participation was approved by unanimous consent.

III. PUBLIC COMMENT

No requests received.

IV. SENATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE CHAIR'S REMARKS

Faculty senator (FAA) and SEC Chair, Jeffrey Eric Jenkins shared the following remarks. Chair Jenkins noted today's business that is before the Senate – the Senate Committee on University Statutes and Senate Procedures (SP) has brought forward a proposal, that is commonly referred to as ST-83; and the Senate Committee on Educational Policy (EP) has brought forward a proposal to create the School of Computing and Data Science in the Grainger College of Engineering. Jenkins noted these items as important parts of shared governance that Senate committees are involved with. He encouraged senators to nominate themselves and colleagues to serve on Senate committees. The Senate Committee on Committees (CC) is working to fill the annual committee vacancies. With vacancies on each committee, there are plenty of opportunities available.

As the end of the semester nears, Chair Jenkins encouraged everyone to take care of themselves and those around them, and to use the abundant resources available to faculty, staff, and students.

Emails have been sent to employees from SURS (State University Retirement System) regarding the SURS trustee election. Jenkins noted that one of the candidates is from the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign and urged senators to vote.

V. CHANCELLOR'S REMARKS

Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and Provost John Coleman shared the following remarks. Provost Coleman noted that there are only six weeks of instruction remaining in the spring semester. During this stressful time senators were reminded to take care of themselves and those around them, and to utilize the available resources.

There continues to be delays receiving FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) information. The attempted simplification of this annual process has seen many complications. This delay affects all institutions across the nation, and many, including Illinois, have extended their acceptance deadline from May 1 to May 15.

A comprehensive brand platform for Illinois has been formulated by the Strategic Communications and Marketing team, StratCom, led by Associate Chancellor Robin Kaler. This platform will provide tools, training, support, and services to help communications professionals across campus tell the story of Illinois consistently and in a unified voice.

Provost Coleman announced that Christopher Span, Chancellor's Chief of Staff and Associate Chancellor for Administration and PreK-12 Initiatives, is leaving Illinois to take on the role of dean for the Graduate School of Education at Rutgers University–New Brunswick. CSpan will be missed.

The Illinois Men's Basketball team has advanced to the NCAA (National Collegiate Athletic Association) Division I Elite Eight, which has not happened since 2005. The Illinois Women's Basketball team is participating in the inaugural WBIT (Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament) which is a women's national college basketball tournament run by the NCAA.

VI. QUESTIONS

Faculty senator Cromley (EDUC) expressed concern about the various obstacles that are making conducting research more difficult. Provost Coleman acknowledged Cromley's concerns and the valuable time it takes to comply with training and other research requirements. Reducing obstacles in conducting research is a common goal.

Academic professional senator Meschewski (AP) asked about the Associate Vice Chancellor for Native Affairs position that Jacki Rand is currently filling and if it will be filled moving forward. Coleman replied that Rand is on a fixed term contract ending in August 2024. The Vice Chancellor for Diversity, Equity & Inclusion, Sean Garrick, will share information once it becomes available.

Faculty senator Belmont (LAS) inquired about research safety protocols and the increased burden put on faculty; who regulates those making the regulations? Coleman noted that the federal government makes updates and changes periodically, but that he would bring this issue to Vice Chancellor for Research and Innovation, Susan Martinis.

X. PROPOSALS

04/01/24-10 EP.24.082* Creation of the School of Computing and Data Science in the Grainger College of Engineering

On behalf of the Senate Committee on Educational Policy (EP), Chair Miller introduced and moved approval of EP.24.082. Miller noted that all the statutory and Senate requirements had been met, including the unanimous approval by EP. Overall, senators appeared to support the proposal.

One issue that arose was the idea of a formal campus governance structure around data science. Miller assured senators that this has been discussed and there are plans to address this issue. Dean of the Grainger College of Engineering, Rashid Bashir reassured senators that the Grainger College of Engineering does not have a monopoly on data science nor on the use of the name “data science”. After additional discussion between senators and proposal sponsors, debate concluded, and a vote was taken.

- 04/01/24-11 By i-clicker and show of hands, item EP.24.082 was approved with 110 in favor, 2 opposed, and 4 abstentions.
- 04/01/24-12 SP.22.01* Proposed Revision to the *Statutes* (USC ST-83)
- On behalf of the Senate Committee on University Statutes and Senate Procedures (SP), Chair Dalpiaz introduced and moved approval of SP.22.01. Dalpiaz provided additional background information found in the proposal since this item has been on the SP agenda since receipt of the University Senates Conference (USC) transmittal letter dated September 2021. Due to the complexity of the proposed changes and the lack of clarity in the problem the proposal is trying to address, SP recommends rejecting ST-83.
- 04/01/24-13 By i-clicker and show of hands, the Senate approved item SP.22.01 with 108 in favor, 3 opposed, and 5 abstentions. Approval of SP.22.01 signifies that the Senate is rejecting the proposed changes to the *Statutes* in ST-83. This approved document will be submitted to USC as the Senate’s rejection of ST-83.
- 04/01/24-14 SP.24.08* Revision to the *Bylaws*, Part D.8 – Committee on Educational Policy (membership)
- On behalf of SP, Chair Dalpiaz introduced and moved approval of SP.24.08. Dalpiaz shared that this proposal removes one *ex officio* member of EP which is a vacant position in the Office of the Provost will not be filling. This proposal then adds two other *ex officio* members that are involved in general education requirements.
- 04/0124-15 By i-clicker and show of hands, item SP.24.08 was approved with 113 in favor, 0 opposed, and 2 abstentions. The required two-thirds majority was achieved.
