CC.26.18 Election of a **Student Member** to the Ad Hoc Committee on the Honorary Degree Awards Process

### **BACKGROUND**

The Ad Hoc Committee on the Honorary Degree Awards Process will examine the current honorary degree awards process and determine if the process is efficient, effective, and appropriately balances faculty engagement with the University's need. The Committee will also ensure the process for granting honorary degree awards reflects best practices and maintains consistency with the University's mission and values.

Excerpt from the Statutes, Article II, Section 1.

d. Each senate shall recommend candidates for honorary degrees...

The Committee will advise the Senate on the process of discharging this obligation and will make recommendations to the Senate through the Senate Executive Committee to strengthen the process for the future, ensuring it continues to reflect academic excellence and the University's highest standards.

Each nominee must be a member of the student electorate as defined by <a href="Article IV of the Senate Constitution">Article IV of the Senate Constitution</a>.
