EP.26.157 Report on Administrative Action for Programs with Red Boxed Courses, General Education Table Edits in Program of Study Tables, or 'Catalog Editing' Changes

In an effort to ensure the Academic Catalog reflects current course offerings and thus accurately reflects current program requirements, the Provost's office, in consultation with the Senate Educational Policy Committee Chair, took the following types of administrative actions:

- Updating programs with "red box errors" as identified via a CIM-P system report. Red box errors may occur when courses in the program of study table are, for example, no longer active and are in a choose from list or have changed rubric, course number, or credit hours.
- Programs needing the General Education table added to the Program of Study table or editing due to reflect current general education course certification status.
- Programs needing the General Education table revised due to general education course certification or decertification.
- 'Catalog editing' changes, such as when the major requirements are being added into the concentration CIM-P record and there is no change to the program itself.

For these instances listed above, the Provost's office took one of two types of administrative action to make the corrections:

- For programs that were "at rest" in the CIM-P system, the Provost's office designee made the necessary edits and administratively saved the revised program record. In this type of administrative save, the program record did not go through any workflow steps.
- For programs with only the type of edits described in this document that were initiated by a sponsor and thus already in workflow, when they reached the Provost queue, the Provost's office designee updated the remaining workflow to move the program record directly from the Provost queue to the DMI step in workflow.

6. **Revise the Bachelor of Science in Liberal Arts and Sciences in Molecular & Cellular Biology in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (key 705)** - modifies the formatting of the Program of Study and additional text (e.g., graduation requirements, university requirements, and general education requirements) to adhere to the campus General Education Template and adds the subheading “Major Requirements” after the new General Education Template information and above the major coursework table for increased accessibility and clarity.

7. **Revise the Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Arts and Sciences in Asian American Studies in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (key 266)** - modifies the formatting of the Program of Study and additional text (e.g., graduation requirements, university requirements, and general education requirements) to adhere to the campus General Education Template and adds the subheading “Major Requirements” after the new General Education Template information and above the major coursework table for increased accessibility and clarity.

11. **Revise the Concentration in Piano Pedagogy in the Master of Music in Music in the College of Fine and Applied Arts and the Graduate College (key 821)** - adds major requirements (total hours and ‘other requirements’ table) to this concentration program of study, adds learning outcomes in CIM-P Program Regulation and Assessment section, and adds external accreditor information to CIM-P Program Features.
12. **Revise the Concentration in Vocal Coaching & Accompanying in the Master of Music in Music in the College of Fine and Applied Arts and the Graduate College (key 822)** - adds major requirements (total hours and ‘other requirements’ table) to this concentration program of study and adds external accreditor information to CIM-P Program Features.
