Proposal to terminate the Teacher Education Minor in Physical Education through the Department of Kinesiology in the College of Applied Life Studies

BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

Request to terminate the Teacher Education Minor in Physical Education because of changes by the Illinois State Board of Education.

JUSTIFICATION:

Due to the new flexibility in the Physical Education Endorsement recognized by the Illinois State Board of Education, and because of the lack on student enrollment in the Teacher Education Minor in Physical Education we are requesting that this program of study be terminated. Student enrollment for the previous five academic years has consistently been at zero, with no student completing the minor requirements in that time period. Currently, students enrolled in a secondary education major who are interested in obtaining certification to teach physical education can do so by completing the Physical Education Endorsement requirements. Therefore, the need for the Teacher Education Minor in Physical Education has become obsolete.
