PROPOSAL TITLE: Change the name of the joint Master of Science in Electrical Engineering and Master of Business Administration degree.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: The Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering wishes to change the name of the joint *Master of Science in Electrical Engineering and Master of Business Administration* degree program to *Master of Science in Electrical and Computer Engineering and Master of Business Administration*. The relevant program code is 10KS8113None.

JUSTIFICATION: This request will correct an oversight. The names of the M.S. and Ph.D. degrees were changed from Electrical Engineering to Electrical and Computer Engineering several years ago, but the joint degree program name was not changed at that time.

STATEMENT FOR PROGRAMS OF STUDY CATALOG: This change affects only one line in the Programs of Study description for Electrical and Computer Engineering. A corresponding change should be made under the Programs of Study *Joint Degree Programs* description for the MBA.
